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**“Blessed are the pure in heart; for they shall see God.” Matthew 5:8**

With all of the corruption in Government, the indoctrination within the government schools, the injustice in the courts, the lies in the media, and many saltless cotton candy pulpits, the American family is endangered, and many souls are at risk for eternity. What is Christian duty under these circumstances? Let me add some Scripture and some research from evangelist Ted Weiland.

Let us look at Scripture and then history. In Acts 5:27-28, 40 ...when the rulers had brought Peter, John and the other apostles, they set them before the council; and the high priest asked them, saying, Did not we command you that you should not teach in this name? And, behold, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us....and when they had called the apostles, and beaten them, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Yhshua, and let them go.

For their good deeds, the Apostles were again imprisoned, tried, and even scourged. Yet how did the Apostles respond? Did they finally submit?

Acts 5:29, 41-42, Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, **We ought to (must) obey God rather than men.** ...And they departed from the presence of the council rejoicing

that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name. And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Yhshua the Christ.

He that justifies the wicked, and he that condemns the just, even they both are abominations to God. Proverbs 17:15

And it shall be, when the ruler sits upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of God's law in a book....And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them. Deuteronomy 17: 18-19

...And thou shall teach them ordinances and laws, and shall show them the way wherein they must walk, and the work that they must do. Moreover you shall provide out of the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them... Exodus 18:19-21

From these passages, and there are others, God outlined some of the qualifications for civil rulers. They must: **\*\*\*Obey God rather than men \*\*\*** **Fear God \*\*\*** **Fear not man \*\*\*** **Be schooled in the laws of God \*\*\*** **Write out their own copy of God's Law \*\*\*** **Daily read God's Law \*\*\*** **Observe the laws of God scrupulously in their own lives \*\*\*** **Be righteous individuals \*\*\*** **Be men of truth \*\*\*** **Be impartial in**

**judgment \*\*\*** **Be unable to be bribed \*\*\*** **Hate dishonest gain \*\*\*** **be ministers of God for good.**

Know you not, that to whom you yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants you are to whom you obey...? Romans 6:16

The principle of Paul's warning is self-evident: Anyone who submits to the ungodly decrees of men becomes a slave of men. On the other hand, if a government is a "minister of God," that is, if it is carrying out God's will, then submission to such a government is simply submission to God Himself. Submission to ungodly decrees is rebellion to God, and it transgresses God's mandate.

With all the corruption in leadership of both major parties, the people groan. We must resist submitting to any ungodly laws of men.

You are bought with a price; be not you the servants (slaves) of men. 1 Corinthians 7:23

Let History now speak, King James I stated in 1603, "A king ceases to be a king, and degenerates into a tyrant, as soon as he leaves off to rule according to his laws." In 1643, Pastor Samuel Rutherford wrote *Lex, Rex, or The Law and the Prince* in which he explained: ...God has given no absolute and unlimited power to a king above the law of God"...

Therefore, an unjust king, as unjust, is not that genuine ordinance of God... So we may resist the injustice of the king, and not resist the king. If, then, any cast off the nature of a king, and become habitually a tyrant, in so far he is not from God... If the office of a tyrant... be contrary to a king's office, it is not from God, and so neither is the power from God."

William Blackstone had commentaries that were read throughout the colonies and helped the Colonists understand their rights coming into the Revolution, and in 1765 he stated it this way, "No human laws are of any validity if contrary to the Law of God."

Pastor Samuel Cooke, preaching at Cambridge, Mass. in 1770 before the Lieutenant Governor, declared: Justice also requires of rulers, in their legislative capacity, that they attend to the operation of their own acts, and repeal whatever laws, upon an impartial review, they find to be inconsistent with the laws of God, the rights of men, and the general benefit to society. This the community has a right to expect.

Follow this in 1860 by the truth spoken by John Thornton who said: "We may very safely assert these two things in general without undermining government: One is, that no civil rulers are to be obeyed when they enjoin things that are inconsistent with the commands of God. All such disobedience is lawful and glorious... All commands running counter to the declared will of God, the Supreme Legislator of heaven and earth, are null and void, and therefore disobedience to them is a duty, not a crime."

Rather than manifesting virtue, our current government instead commits such atrocities as:

- \*Approving of and even promoting the indiscriminate massacre of our unborn progeny.
- \*Engaging in the destruction of our Christian heritage and culture.
- \*Maintaining an unbiblical and confiscatory tax on our land and property.

\*Levying oppressive taxation on wages. Thomas Jefferson made it clear that we ought not be forced to underwrite legislation that supports immorality: "...to compel a man to furnish contributions of money for the propagation of opinions (or actions) which he disbelieves and abhors, is sinful and tyrannical..."

\*Failing to condemn, and even financing homosexuality, pornography, and other such abominations.

\*Conspiring to disarm its subjects.

\*Selling its own subjects via international treaties into world government slavery.

The following maxim seems to apply more and more in recent years: "No one's life, liberty, or property is safe while the legislature (and court) is in session."

Give, O Lord, a discerning spirit and the ability to tell who is speaking truth & who is not.

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Restoring America's Foundation on Jesus is the only thing that will save our families and our country. God is Sovereign, and we must have a vision to raise up godly generations that will fill America and the earth with God's standards. Raise us a generation who "know their father's God and serve Him with a whole heart and a willing mind." Ones who love and serve the Lord with all of their heart, mind, soul, and strength.

I have committed the rest of my life to this, and with the love and forgiveness of Jesus, I ask you to continue to join me in prayer and supplication, love and support for this mission to a dying generation. Because of your love, prayers and support, you have been a part of saving lives, and bringing souls to Jesus again this year already.

I am going to ask each of you to intensify your prayers for the urgency of the times. Things are hard on many of us. We need help anyway you can. Let us all be like the founders that pledged

their lives, their fortunes, and their sacred honor. The children in America depend on you right now, at the most urgent times that our country has ever faced.

I had a close friend ask why I was running for Governor and how it would affect the ministry that God has given us. It will affect the ministry in a positive way, as I am running for Governor to bring honor and glory to God back into the leadership of this country.
